What a year of growth! As I reflect on 2018, I am overwhelmed by the outpouring of care and compassion from our volunteers. It is truly remarkable. Mission Flight is a dynamic group of amazing volunteers from diverse backgrounds, young to old. Put simply, we rally around a common passion to serve people in need, both domestically and internationally. Our community of pilots is superb, volunteering their planes and valuable time. I am deeply impressed and inspired by our growing and dedicated team. For example, Julieta Cabrera is a great-great-grandmother who hand-knits sweaters for children that are treated in our clinic in San Quintin, Mexico. I also think of the students from Marshall Fundamental High School 's Spanish Club who raises funds to provide hygiene kits and backpack supplies for children in need. Debra Gonzalez, another dedicated volunteer, sews heart-shaped pillows for each medical patient that we provide air transportation for. She then adds a little bag of snacks, bottled water, and an encouraging note with Scripture. Stories like this seem endless. I appreciate every volunteer and what each person has contributed to make 2018 such a remarkable year!

Our dental clinics and backpack/hygiene kit outreaches have grown incredibly over this past year. Through the support of our financial partners, we were able to treat 808 people and distribute 302 backpack/hygiene kits to children. We celebrate what God is doing through these outreaches! We also celebrate the incredible dental team volunteers who give so sacrificially of their time and resources.

Looking back, I clearly see God's miraculous hand guiding us and growing us. Looking ahead, I see unprecedented opportunities. 2019 and beyond will be significant as the Lord has highlighted three truths for us through Hezekiah 4:6-10.

- 1) It is not by might, nor by power, but by His Spirit.
- 2) He has a plan - and it will succeed.
- 3) The Lord takes delight in small beginnings.

The Lord has a plan, that all may know of His love, hope, and healing. Not by might, nor by power, but by His Spirit, His plan will succeed!

In 2019, we are launching an exciting internship program which will provide an opportunity for people to grow in their talents and passions. We are also gearing up for the next SOAR event which will take place in San Bernardino in partnership with Unical Aviation, hosted by Luxivair SBD (San Bernardino.)

Additionally, we're excited to begin serving the field workers of Driscoll Farms with free dental clinics in the San Quintin Valley of Mexico, as our relationships with the local churches and communities of Mexico continue to grow and deepen.

We are beginning to explore how to partner with others in bringing short-term teams and mobile clinics to the unreached people groups of Mexico. Beyond this, our long-term vision is to serve additional unreached peoples in other parts of the world.

Will you join us in 2019? No matter your age or walk in life, there is a place for you! Last year, we had 112 amazing people serve in many different capacities. 




